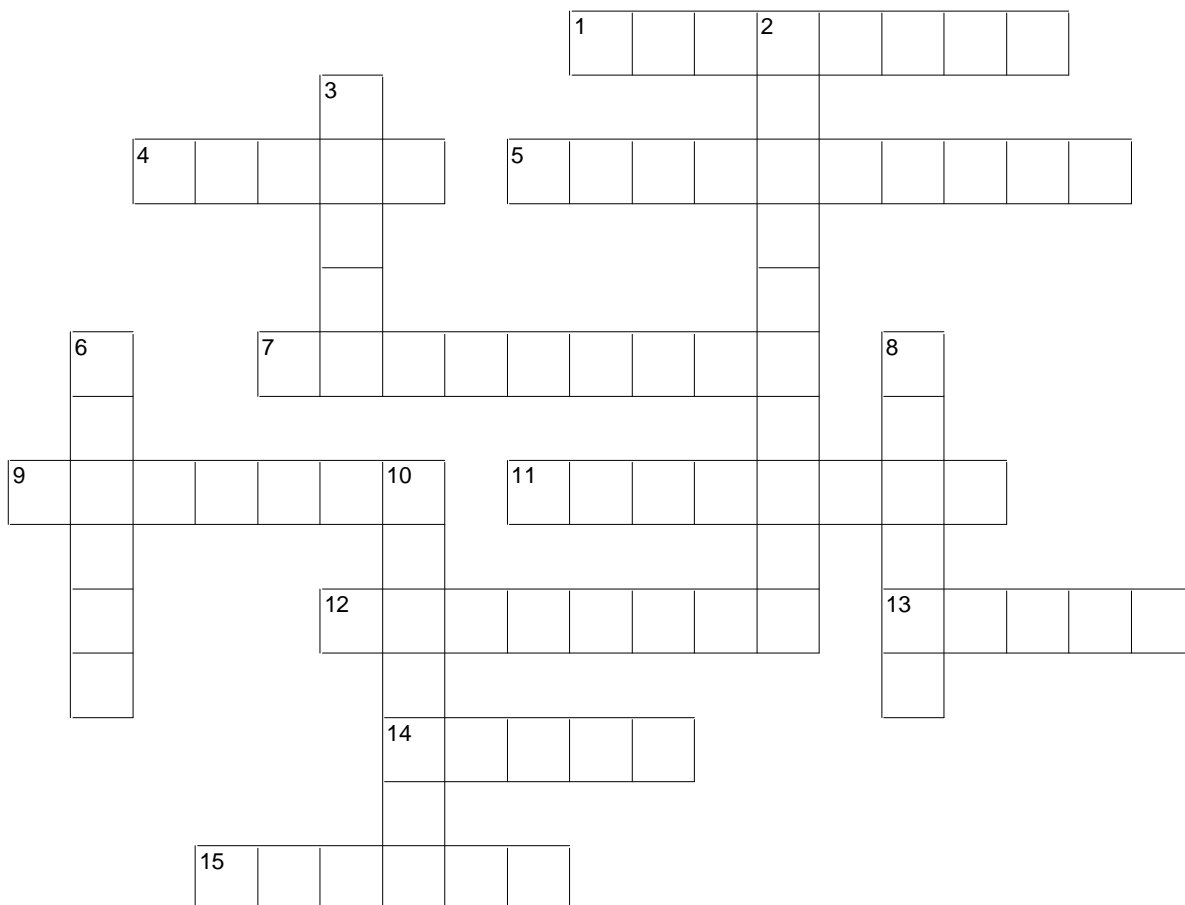

- 15 The duration of notes and rests

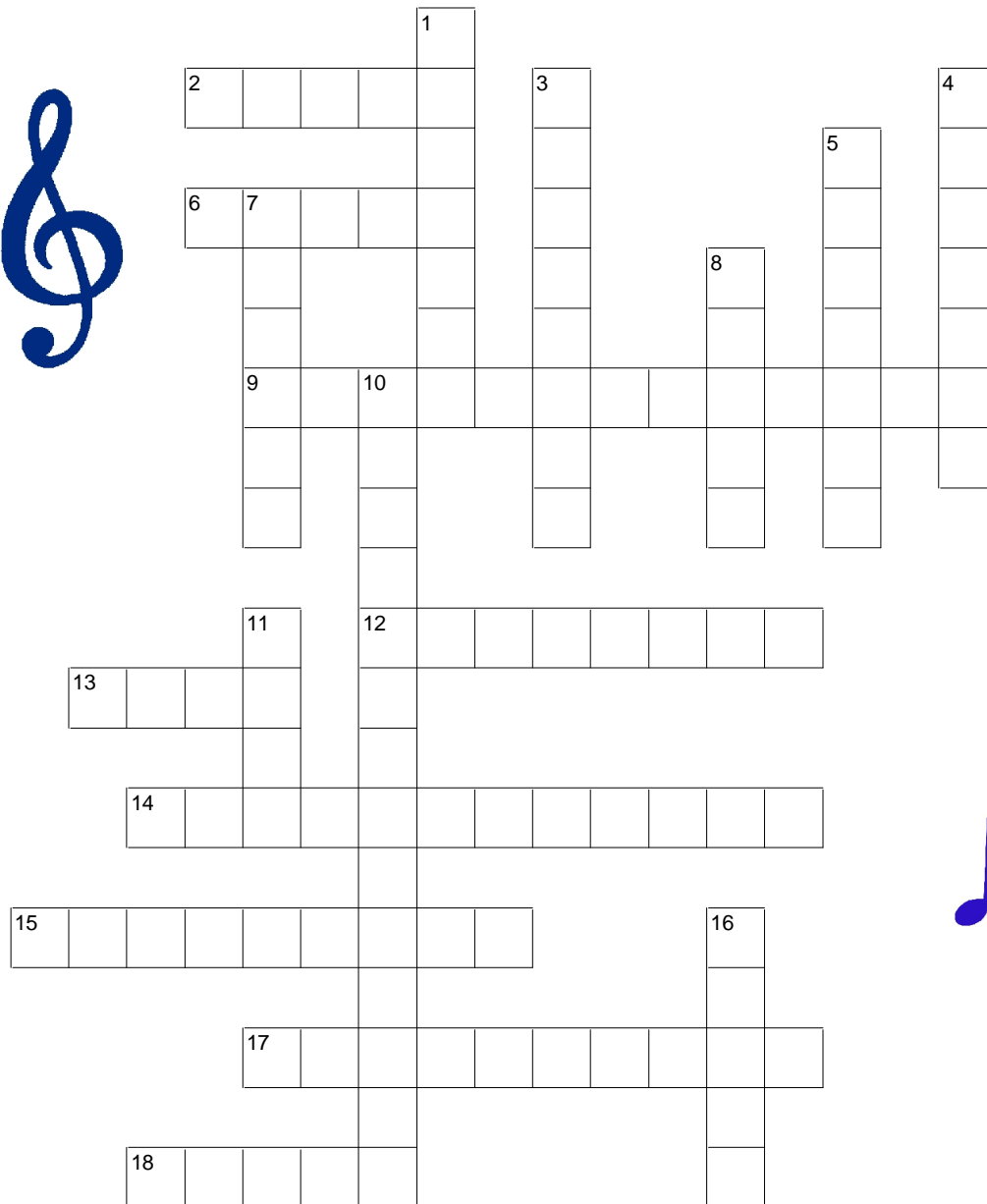
## DOWN
